

Minimum three years of full-time pre-medicine studies  
 Four years of full-time study at UBC  
 Minimum two years of full-time residency training  
 Degree Awarded: Doctor of Medicine

**Admission Requirements:**

Admission to University of British Columbia Faculty of Medicine requires at least three years (90 credits) of Arts and Science courses. Typically, students apply after the completion of a full undergraduate degree.

No particular degree program is considered ideal for the study of medicine; therefore, students may choose any academic program from the Faculty of Arts or Science. Courses in behavioral sciences, biometrics, statistics and physics are recommended, but are not required.
